84.17 NEW ISSUES

85.17 CONTINUING ISSUES

• The Clerk has posted key receipts to the new key holders at the football club, but has only had two returned.

- Hire agreements have been prepared for the Football and Cricket Clubs, and annual hire fees
 have been agreed. The Cricket Club have requested a delayed payment date and/or paying in
 instalments as they have low reserves and their income is now spread throughout the
 summer.
- **86.17** It was agreed that the Cricket Club will pay in two instalments on 1 June 2018 and 1 September 2018.

87.17 PLAYFIELD ROAD PAVILION FEASIBILITY STUDY

The possible options for the location of the building and car parking provision were discussed.

88.17 It was resolved that Cllr, Feather will write up the discussion and circulate to members of the playing fields committee for input before submitting out ideas to the architect. It is hoped that the location of the building can be agreed to take the project forward.

90.17 Cllr. Mrs. Buckingham – Queried if the fridges have now been removed from Forest Side. Mrs. Lewington reported that they had.

- **91.17 Mr. Lewington** Questioned whether there would be any off-season grounds maintenance. The Clerk is obtaining quotes for the over-seeding to be done this spring, and estimates will be taken to the April parish council meeting.
- **92.17 Clir. Charlett** The white line machine is still being emptied by the entrance to the playing field. This is unfair to the parents of children who then walk through it on their way into the playground.

ACTION FOR MR LEWINGTON – Take back to football club again

93.17 Mr Gardiner – The weeds are back around the pavilion, and need to be cleared.

ACTION FOR CLERK – Send a note to the committee with the minutes, requesting volunteers for a working party to clear the weeds
