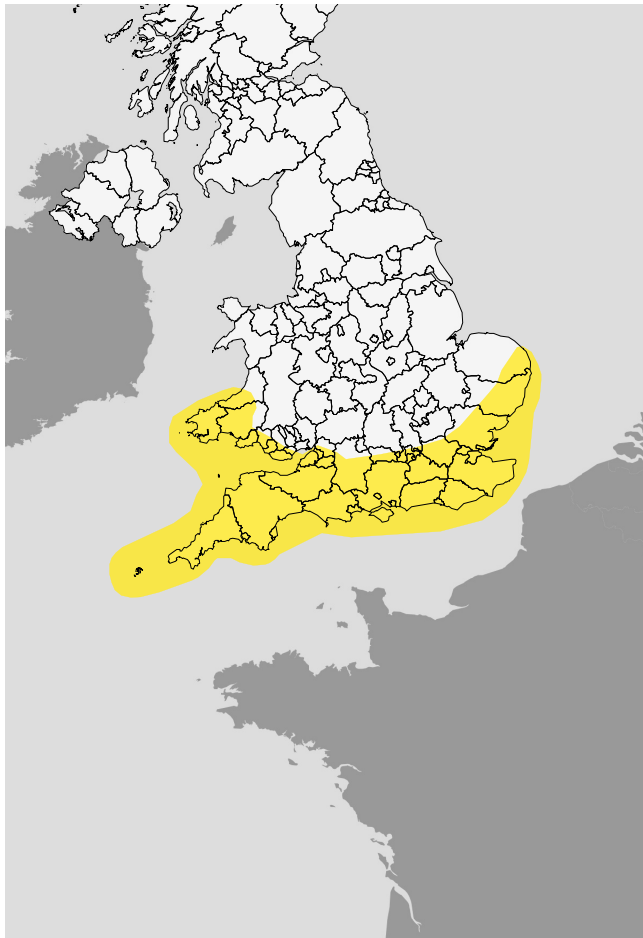


**Yellow warning**

**23:59 Thu 2 Nov 2023**



**Very strong and potentially damaging winds associated with Storm Ciarán are likely late Wednesday onwards into Thursday.**

### What to expect

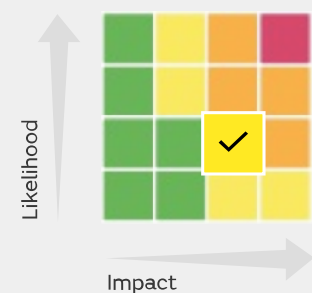
- Injuries and danger to life from flying debris are possible
- Some damage to buildings, such as tiles blown from roofs, could happen
- Road, rail, air and ferry services may be affected, with longer journey times and cancellations possible
- Some roads and bridges may close
- Power cuts may occur, with the potential to affect other services, such as mobile phone coverage
- Injuries and danger to life could occur from large waves and beach material being thrown onto sea fronts, coastal roads and properties

### Further details

Storm Ciarán is likely to bring a spell of very strong winds to southern parts of the UK.

Winds are likely to frequently gust 50-60 mph inland, perhaps 70 mph in a few exposed locations, mainly coasts and hills. Very large waves could bring additional impacts to coastal areas. Winds will gradually ease from the west later in the afternoon and through the evening.

Separate amber warnings for southwest England and coastal regions of southern England have been issued.

Here winds potentially gusting 70-80 mph and in excess of 85 mph in a few exposed locations.

A reduction in impact levels from high to medium. Amber warnings cover the regions where there is still potential for high impacts.
