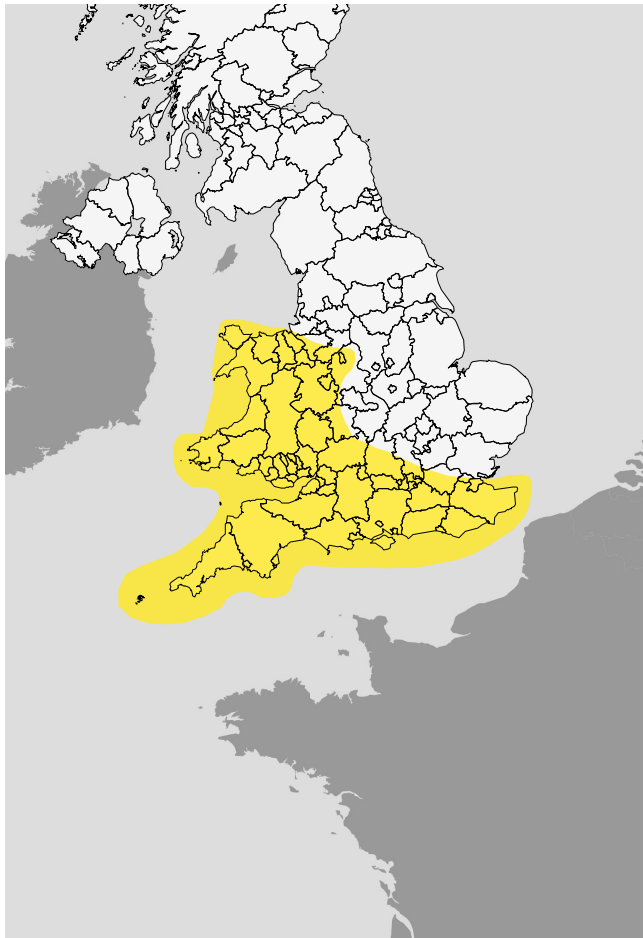


**Yellow warning
Rain**

23:59 Thu 2 Nov 2023



Heavy rain associated with Storm Ciarán is likely to bring disruption to parts of England and Wales.

What to expect

- Delays or cancellations to train and bus services are possible
- Homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Some communities may be cut off by flooded roads
- Fast flowing or deep floodwater is possible, causing a danger to life

Further details

Periods of heavy rain, associated with Storm Ciarán, are expected to affect much of southern and western England and Wales from Wednesday evening and throughout Thursday. Over southern England rain may be accompanied by occasional rumbles of thunder in a few places.

A further 20-30 mm is likely quite widely, but 40-60 mm may accumulate in a number of places, especially, but not exclusively, over higher ground. Upland areas of southwest England and Wales may see 80 mm of rain in a few locations with the potential for in excess of 100 mm in a few locations across north Wales.
