Protocol for what gets posted on the Village Website Agreed on 8 December 2016 (minute No. 304.16) Last reviewed on 14 March 2024 (minute no. 509.23)

The Kennington website is owned and managed by Kennington Parish Council and as such has a responsibility to maintain the standard of its contents.

The reason for the website is to welcome all new residents and visitors, giving information from its location and history to its facilities and information of all the many organisations and clubs within Kennington. The website informs its residents of what's going on in the village and around it.

The website is **BY** the village, **FOR** the village and the Council wants it to contain all anyone could reasonably expect to find within the village.

Requests to post events, information and news is continually being received, some of which could be thought of as inappropriate. Below is a list of what is acceptable to be posted and a list of what is not acceptable for inclusion:

ACCEPTABLE

- Information regarding any village organisation, community group or club
- Information related to the village e.g. road closures
- Events being held in the village by outside bodies but inviting Kennington residents
- Information regarding non-profit making organisations

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Anything promoting a political point of view
- General advertising
- Commercial advertising

As with the Kennington Chronicle – news not views.
