

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(RADLEY PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 82(2), 83(2) & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Radley Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive at a speed in excess of 20mph in any of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. The lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
4. No person shall drive at a speed in excess of 30mph in any of the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
5. No person shall drive at a speed in excess of 40mph in any of the roads specified in Schedule 3 to this order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Radley Parish) (Restricted Roads) Order 2000 is hereby revoked / replaced.

20mph speed limit:

All roads within the 'North West Radley' residential development, leading out to the following points:

a)	Unnamed North-western Access Road	its junction with Church Road
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b)	Unnamed South-eastern Access Road	its junction with Whites Lane

30mph speed limit:

a)	Badgers Copse	its entire length	
b)	Catharine Close	its entire length	
c)	Church Road	its entire length

j)	Little Howe Close	Its entire length	
k)	New Road	Its entire length	
l)	Norfolk Close	Its entire length	
m)	St James Road	Its entire length	
n)	St James Terrace	its entire length	
o)	Selwyn Crescent	its entire length	
p)	Shaw's Copse	its entire length	
q)	Spinneys Close	its entire length	
r)	Stonhouse Crescent	its entire length	
s)	Sugworth Crescent	its entire length	
t)	Sugworth Lane (Eastern end)	from its junction with Kennington Road, westwards	for a distance of 185 metres to a point 190 metres west of its junction with the access to 'Bigwood Park'
u)	Sugworth Lane (Western end)	from its junction with the Oxford Road eastwards	for a distance of 346 metres

v)	Thrupp Lane	from its junction with Norfolk Close southwards and then westwards	for a distance of 306 metres
w)	Turners Close	its entire length	
x)	White's Lane	its entire length	
y)	The unnamed road looping Lower Radley	its entire length	
z)	Radley Road	its entire length

a)	Kennington Road	From a point 22 metres south of its junction with Sugworth Lane, southwards	to a point 504 metres north of its junction with Church Road
