Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

LOCATION: Kennington, Sandford Lane

REASON: To facilitate carriageway patching works

DURATION: Starting on 15 October 2024
The anticipated completion date is 16 October 2024
(date included). This will operate between 20:00 and
06:00
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5
consecutive days.)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for emergency service
vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of
road, subject to the progress of the works. Access will
be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians but
marshalled at the extents of the site

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place
yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the
highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: No diversion, dead end road
